Term Planner

A Term 1 Planner is included in this newsletter and will also be sent home in hard copy format.

You may notice on the Term Planner that NAPLAN has been moved from Term 2 to Term 1. This is applicable across Australia. As a result, the swimming times for each class are currently being scheduled to fit around the NAPLAN schedule of testing.

You may also notice that Sports day has not been scheduled in Term 1 as in previous years. This is due to the high number of events at the end of Term 1 (Swimming weeks, NAPLAN testing, Parent-Teacher meetings, Easter). We have scheduled Sports day at the end of Term 3 in time for Spring weather, this will also ensure we have enough space for activities once our building works are complete.

Classroom teachers have been distributing information about class learning and routines this week; we hope you have found this useful. To further share information about the year ahead, we are looking forward to welcoming parents to an Acquaintance Evening in Week 3 (Tuesday 14th February). Details will be shared soon.

Back to School Information

2023 Language Learning

In 2022, GGPS parents were invited to participate in a survey regarding the offering of languages at our school. The survey results told us that there are very differing views across our parent and student community! A large percentage of parents were keen to consider a change in language from Japanese, many wanted Auslan to be offered, some were keen on Spanish but others were very passionate about maintaining Japanese.

As a result, this year we sought to employ both a Japanese teacher and an Auslan teacher. We found however that in this new era of teacher shortages, language teachers are indeed in short supply and although we have been successful in securing an Auslan teacher (Welcome Charisa!), we are yet to find a Japanese teacher.

The current plan is for Reception to Year 2 students to engage with Japanese in Terms 1 & 2 and then to have Auslan in Terms 3 & 4. The opposite is the plan for Year 3 – 6, with those classes beginning with Auslan from this week.

We hope to share information with you soon regarding a Japanese teacher.

School Yard Opening & Closing Times

The school yard is supervised by a yard duty teacher each morning before school from 8:30am. We ask that parents and students do not enter the yard, the playground or oval before this time as those areas are used for the Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) program until 8:30am.

Between 8:30am and 8:50am, all students are invited to play on the Hard Play until classroom doors open (playground/oval/nature play areas are unsupervised and therefore not open prior to the school bell).

The OSHC program also uses external play areas including the yard, the COLA, the playground and the oval each afternoon. We ask that parents vacate those areas by 3:30pm to enable OSHC staff to have clear view and duty of care of students who are using OSHC services.

Classroom Door Opening Times

Our school day begins at 8:50am. While some teachers open their doors earlier than this, the general expectation is that doors will open by 8:50am and that learning begins shortly after morning routines are taken care of. We encourage all parents to allow children to unpack their own belongings each morning (COVID restrictions taught us that they develop their independence very quickly if encouraged to undertake routines independently). We also kindly ask parents to depart classrooms shortly after the bell (and prior to 9:00am) when formal learning commences.

Vacation Care

Reminder: The Cobbler Creek Vacation Care program will not be available to families during the Term 1 holidays. This is due to the school's building project which, for the two weeks, will involve the removal of hazardous materials, including asbestos. While such demolition/removals are undertaken, the school and grounds cannot be occupied by staff, parents and students.

OSHC staff will communicate suggestions for alternative care in the near future.
