We have recently updated our emergency evacuation and shelter-in-place procedures and will soon begin to familiarise students with new audio notification alerts.

Communication with families has been added to our procedures and as such, parents will be kept informed of evacuation and shelter-in-place practice "drills" as they occur.

AFTERNOON DISMISSAL

We currently have a growing number of students remaining in the Hardplay area or in the COLA after the 3:05pm siren. In addition to reported incidents of unsupervised and unsafe play, this is also creating challenges for OSHC who use this area for their afternoon programs.

We ask that parents accompany their children from the school yard as soon as they have been dismissed and/or arrange for children to meet at the front of the school where teacher supervision is available.
