Native Garden Planting Day

A beautiful new garden has been planted in our school to attract native butterflies, birds and insects.

Our Specialist Science teacher, Haylee Garner, with the support of Naomi Findlay from Green Adelaide and our Year 6 Environmental Leaders, created a landscape design incorporating 13 different species of native plants.

Haylee colour coded the design on the ground in readiness for planting and each one of our students helped to plant over 800 tube stock plants. In six months or so, we look forward to seeing a spray of colour in this area!

First time readers will receive a certificate for completing the challenge of reading 12 books this year.


