Congratulations to the 493 students who completed this year's Premier's Reading Challenge and will be receiving their award in Term 4.

First time readers will receive a certificate for completing the challenge of reading 12 books this year.

Continuing students will be awarded Bronze, Silver, Gold, Champion or Legend and Hall of Fame medals according to their participation over the years. Students receiving a Hall of Fame medal will have their name proudly included on the Hall of Fame list on the PRC website https://premiersreadingchallenge.sa.edu.au/hall-of-fame/

This year is the $20^{\text {th }}$ anniversary of the PRC so 411 of our students who read and recorded an additional 8 books, for a total of 20 , will be also be awarded a special anniversary certificate. All awards will be presented in Term 4.
